

**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO
AMEND BRIEFING AND HEARING SCHEDULE FOR
MOTION FOR DETERMINATION OF THE AMOUNT,
CLASSIFICATION AND ALLOWANCE OF REAL PROPERTY TAX
CLAIM OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR**

Upon the motion (the "Motion") of the Reorganized Debtors in the above-captioned cases,¹ for entry of an order amending the briefing and hearing schedule for the DCHC Liquidating Trust's Motion for Determination of the Amount, Classification and Allowance of Real Property Tax Claim of Los Angeles County Tax Collector (the "Tax Determination"),

Motion") and it appearing that the DCHC Liquidating Trust does not oppose the relief sought in the Motion and that no other or further notice need be given; and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby ORDERED that:

- A. the Motion is GRANTED; and
- B. the date set in paragraph 2 of this Court's Order Continuing Hearing on the DCHC Liquidating Trust's Motion for Determination of the Amount, Classification and Allowance of Real Property Tax Claim of Los Angeles County Tax Collector (docket entry # 2635, the "Initial Order") by which the Reorganized Debtors must file their brief on issues pertaining to responsibility for the real property taxes for on the real property of Pacifica Hospital of the Valley Corporation with respect to the 2002-2003 tax year is hereby extended to and including September 1, 2005; and
- C. the date set in paragraph 3 of this Court's Initial Order by which parties may file responses to the Reorganized Debtors' brief is hereby extended to and including September 19, 2005; and
- D. the date set in paragraph 4 of this Court's Initial Order by which the Reorganized Debtors shall file a reply to any responding brief filed in accordance with paragraph 3 of the Initial Order (as amended by this Order) is hereby extended to and including September 26, 2005; and
- E. the date and time set in paragraph 5 of this Court's Initial Order on which the Court will hold a hearing on the Motion and briefed issues is hereby changed to _____, 2005 at _____ ; and

F. except as modified herein, the Initial Order remains in full force and effect.
