**ORDER REGARDING DESIGNATIONS FOR ADMISSION IN SUPPORT  
OF THE TRUST’S SUPPLEMENTAL OPPOSITION TO PROPOSED  
STIPULATION AND ORDER RESOLVING ALLEGED “CURE CLAIM” OF  
UNIVERSAL CARE, INC. AND REQUEST FOR RELATED RELIEF**

On August 3, 2005, the Trustee for the DCHC Liquidating Trust filed his Designations for Admission in Support of The Trust’s Supplemental Opposition to Proposed Stipulation and Order Resolving Alleged “Cure Claim” of Universal Care, Inc. and Request for Related Relief (the “Designations”).

On August 10, 2005, Universal Care, Inc. filed the Objection of Universal Care, Inc. to Designations for Admission in Support of The Trust’s Supplemental Opposition to Proposed Stipulation and Order Resolving Alleged “Cure Claim” of Universal Care, Inc. and Request for Related Relief (the “Objection to Designations”).

The Court having reviewed the Designations and heard the statements of counsel regarding the relief requested in the Objection to Designations at a hearing before the Court (the “Hearing”); the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection to Designations and at the Hearing establish just cause for the relief requested therein, the Court finds:

- a) the portion of the Trustee's Designations found in the deposition of Mr. Erich Mounce conducted on June 1, 2005, appearing at page 117, lines 3 through 6, is hearsay; and
- b) page 117, lines 3 through 6 of the transcript of the deposition of Mr. Erich Mounce, conducted on June 1, 2005, are not admitted into evidence in this proceeding.
