

**ORDER APPROVING THE TRUST'S
EIGHTEENTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO POSTPETITION CLAIMS
PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 502 AND FED. R. BANKR. P. 3007**

Upon consideration of the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection (the "Eighteenth Omnibus Objection") of The DCHC Liquidating Trust (the "Trust") seeking the entry of an order disallowing and reducing certain claims, and the Submission (the "Submission") of Amended Proposed Order Approving the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection,

FINDING THAT:

1. No previous application for the relief requested therein having been made;

2. The Hospital Association of Southern California (Claim No. 1814) and HCA Inc. (Claim No. 416) each filed a timely opposition to the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection. The Hospital Association of Southern California's opposition and claim was resolved by stipulation filed with the Court on August 19, 2008 (DE 3423).
3. SBC Pacific Bell's claim (Claim No. 1214) was resolved by stipulation filed with the Court on August 25, 2008 (DE 3431).
4. The claims filed by the Hospital Association of Southern California (Claim No. 1814), HCA Inc. (Claim No. 416) and SBC Pacific Bell (Claim No. 1214) have been removed from Exhibit A to this Order (formerly Exhibit A to the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection);
5. Due and proper notice of the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection having been given;
6. Sufficient cause exists for granting the requested relief; and
7. Granting the relief requested is in the best interests of the above-captioned Debtors' estates and creditors.

After due deliberation and cause appearing therefor; it is **HEREBY ORDERED**,

ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. The relief requested in the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection and the Submission is granted to the extent provided in this Order.
2. Each Claim listed on Exhibit A to this Order is disallowed and/or reduced in accordance with the column labeled "Disallowed Claim Amount" detailed on Exhibit A to this Order.
3. The Trust hereby reserves its right to object in the future to any of the claims listed in the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection on any ground, whether legal or equitable, and whether or

not stated herein or on Exhibits A to the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection or in the Submission or on Exhibits A to this Order.

4. Within 10 days of entry of this Order the Trust shall file a certificate of mailing of copies of this Order upon the parties listed on Exhibits A to the Eighteenth Omnibus Objection.
