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**AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULES OF DOCTORS COMMUNITY
HEALTHCARE CORPORATION REMOVING SCHEDULED CLAIM OF TOSHIBA**

Reorganized Debtor Doctors Community Healthcare Corporation n/k/a Envision Hospital Corporation (“DCHC”) hereby amends its Schedules by deleting the scheduled claim of Toshiba, and in support, states as follows:

1. On February 19, 2008, Doctors Community Healthcare Corporation filed its Schedules of Assets and Liabilities (DE 391) (the “DCHC Schedules”). The DCHC Schedules include a “secured” claim in the amount of \$68,220 in favor of “Toshiba” (the “Toshiba Claim”).
2. After filing the DCHC Schedules, DCHC reviewed its books and records and determined that the Toshiba Claim was scheduled in error and that there was no basis for scheduling the Toshiba Claim in any priority. *See Declaration of Erich Mounce* at ¶ 4 (attached as Exhibit A).
3. Rule 1009 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure states in relevant part that “[a] voluntary petition, list, schedule, or statement may be amended by the debtor as a matter of course at any time before the case is closed.” Fed.R.Bank.P. 1009(a). DCHC’s bankruptcy case is not closed.

4. Because the Toshiba Claim was scheduled in error, DCHC hereby deletes and removes the Toshiba Claim from the DCHC Schedules pursuant to Rule 1009(a) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.
