PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on or before **September 17, 2009** you must file and serve a written objection to the Motion of the DCHC Liquidating Trust Seeking Amendment of Order Concerning IRS W-9 Forms and Redistribution of Funds From Nonresponding Class 8 and Class 10 Creditors to Responding Class 8 and Class 10 Creditors (Docket No. 3496) (the "Motion") filed on September 3, 2009, together with the proposed order required by Local Bankruptcy Rule 9072-1. The objection and proposed order must be filed with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, U.S. Courthouse, 3rd and Constitution Ave., N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001, and served (by delivery or mailing of a copy) upon the undersigned. The objection must contain a complete specification of the factual and legal grounds upon which it is based. You may append affidavits and documents in support of your objection.

IF YOU FAIL TO FILE A TIMELY OBJECTION, THE MOTION MAY BE GRANTED BY THE COURT WITHOUT A HEARING. The Court may grant the Motion without a hearing if the objection filed states inadequate grounds for denial of the objection. Parties in interest with questions may contact the undersigned.
