**ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF THE DCHC LIQUIDATING TRUST
SEEKING AN ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES
FOR CASE CLOSURE AND RELATED RELIEF**

Upon consideration of the Motion of The DCHC Liquidating Trust (the “Trust”) Seeking
an Order Establishing Procedures for Case Closure and Related Relief (the “Motion”),

It is **HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The relief requested in the Motion is GRANTED.
2. Exhibit B hereto contains a list of all claimholders in these cases that either (i)
have allowable claims and have submitted W-9 Forms or (ii) have allowable
claims and have until November 23, 2009 to submit valid W-9 Forms.

3. Exhibit C hereto contains a list of all priority and secured Claims that are the Trust's responsibility. The priority or secured portion of each Claim listed on Exhibit C has been paid in full.
4. Exhibit D hereto is a chart containing all amounts paid to the NCFE Entities (Class 9 NCFE Claims) pursuant to the distribution scheme provided in the Plan.
5. Exhibit E hereto contains a list of all claimholders in these cases that (i) have an allowable claim and (ii) have not submitted W-9 Forms or failed to cash their distribution checks. These claims have been and are disallowed pursuant to the W-9 Procedures Order.¹
6. Exhibit F hereto contains a list of all claimholders in these cases that have had their claims disallowed during the administration of these cases, other than the disallowed claims listed on Exhibit E hereto. It is hereby confirmed that such claims are disallowed.
7. The Trust is authorized to send a Notice, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, to each claimholder listed on Exhibits B-F hereto. Claimholders shall have twenty (20) days to object to any of the information, relief or procedures sought therein.
8. Exhibit H hereto is a form of the Trust's proposed second order to the Motion, which seeks approval of the shutdown procedures set forth in the Motion (the "Second Order").
9. A hearing on the Second Order shall be set for [].
