ORDER GRANTING DEBTORS ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE SCHEDULES AND STATEMENTS OF FINANCIAL AFFAIRS

This matter is before the Court on the motion of Dan River Inc. and its debtor affiliates (collectively, the "Debtors") for an extension of time to file the schedules and statements of financial affairs required by Section 521(1) of the Bankruptcy Code and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1007 (the "Motion").

The Court has considered the Motion, the Declaration of Barry F. Shea in Support of First-Day Applications and Motions, and the matters reflected in the record of the hearing held on the Motion. It appears that the Court has jurisdiction over this proceeding; that this is a core proceeding; that notice of the Motion has been given to the Office of the United States Trustee, counsel for the Debtors' pre-petition secured lenders, the indenture trustee for the Debtors' senior note holders, counsel to the Agent for the Debtors' proposed debtor-in-possession lenders, and the Debtors' thirty largest unsecured creditors on a consolidated basis; that no further notice is necessary; that the relief sought in the motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, and their creditors; and that good and sufficient cause exists for such relief.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.

2. The time within which the Debtors are required to file their schedules and statements of financial affairs is hereby extended until 45 days after the date of the commencement of these Chapter 11 cases.

3. The entry of this Order is without prejudice to the right of the Debtors to seek a further extension of time to file their schedules and statements of financial affairs for good cause shown.

4. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation of this Order.
