ORDER GRANTING THE DEBTOR'S MOTION TO SHORTEN THE TIME FOR NOTICE OF THE DEADLINE TO OBJECT TO: (1) THE DEBTOR'S DISCLOSURE STATEMENT (DOCKET NO. 25); (2) THE DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF A FINAL ORDER, (A) AUTHORIZING DEBTOR TO OBTAIN POST-PETITION FINANCING FROM PEOPLES BANK, (B) GRANTING LIENS AND SUPERPRIORITY CLAIMS IN FAVOR OF PEOPLES BANK, (C) AUTHORIZING USE OF PEOPLES BANK'S CASH COLLATERAL, AND (D) GRANTING ADEQUATE PROTECTION TO PEOPLES BANK (DOCKET NO. 12); (3) THE DEBTOR'S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF A FINAL ORDER, (A) AUTHORIZING DEBTOR TO OBTAIN POST-PETITION FINANCING FROM 6801 WEST 107TH, LLC, AND (B) GRANTING LIENS AND SUPERPRIORITY CLAIMS IN FAVOR OF 6801 WEST 107TH, LLC (DOCKET NO. 13)

Upon consideration of the motion (the "Motion") (Docket No. 102)<sup>1</sup> of Dickinson Theatres, Inc. (the "Debtor"), seeking entry of an order for pursuant to Section 105(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and Rule 9006 of the Bankruptcy Rules, shortening the time for notice of the

deadline to object to: (1) the Debtor's Disclosure Statement (the "Disclosure Statement") (Docket No. 25); (2) the Debtor's Motion for Entry of a Final Order, (A) Authorizing Debtor to Obtain Post-Petition Financing From Peoples Bank, (B) Granting Liens and Superpriority Claims in Favor of Peoples Bank, (C) Authorizing Use of Peoples Bank's Cash Collateral, and (D) Granting Adequate Protection to Peoples Bank (the "Peoples Post-Petition Financing Motion") (Docket No. 12); (3) the Debtor's Motion For Entry of a Final Order, (A) Authorizing Debtor to Obtain Post-Petition Financing From 6801 West 107th, LLC, and (B) Granting Liens and Superpriority Claims in Favor of 6801 West 107th, LLC (the "6801 West Post-Petition" Financing Motion," together with the Peoples Post-Petition Financing Motion, the "Financing Motions") (Docket No. 13), so that a hearing may be had on the adequacy of the Disclosure Statement and a final hearing may be had on the Financing Motions at the omnibus hearing schedule for October 25, 2012, at 1:30 p.m. Central Standard Time, and requiring that objections to the adequacy of information contained in the Disclosure Statement, or to the Financing Motions, be filed and received by counsel for the Debtor no later than 12:00 noon Central Standard Time on October 22, 2012; the Court having reviewed the Motion; the Court having considered the statements of counsel and the evidence adduced with respect to the Motion at a hearing thereon; and the Court having found that: (a) the Court has jurisdiction to consider the Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b), and (c) notice of the Motion and the hearing thereon was sufficient under the circumstances and that no further notice need be provided; it appearing that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interest of the Debtor, its estate, and its creditors; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion and adduced at the hearing thereon establish good and sufficient cause for the relief granted herein;

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Motion is **GRANTED** in its entirety.
- 2. Cause exists under Rule 9006 of the Bankruptcy Rules to shorten the period for filing objections to the adequacy of the Debtor's Disclosure Statement.
- 3. Cause exists under Rule 9006 of the Bankruptcy Rules to shorten the period for filing objections to either of the Financing Motions.
- 4. The form of the Special Notice substantially in the form attached to the Motion as <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> is approved.
- 5. The Debtor shall file its Special Notice with respect to the relief granted in this order with the Court's electronic filing system as soon as practicable and serve a copy of its Special Notice upon on all parties required to receive notice as set forth in this Court's order entered on October 2, 2012. (*See* Docket No. 12.)
- 6. Any party seeking to file an objection to the Debtor's Disclosure Statement shall file its objection, and serve same upon counsel for the Debtor, no later than 12:00 noon Central Standard Time on October 22, 2012.
- 7. Any party seeking to file an objection to the entry of a final order with respect to either of the Financing Motions shall file its objection, and serve same upon counsel for the Debtor, no later than 12:00 noon Central Standard Time on October 22, 2012.
- 8. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation of this Order.
- 9. Cause exists to waive the mandatory 21-day notice required by Rule 6003 of the Bankruptcy Rules in order to avoid immediate and irreparable harm to the Debtor's estate.

- 10. Cause exists to waive the mandatory 14-day stay required by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(h).
- 11. Notwithstanding the possible applicability of Bankruptcy Rules 7062, 9014 or otherwise, the terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.
- 12. All time periods set forth in this Order shall be calculated in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 9006(a).
