ORDER AUTHORIZING THE DEBTOR'S REJECTION OF MISCELLANEOUS EXECUTORY CONTRACTS

Upon consideration of the motion (the "Motion")¹ of Dickinson Theatres, Inc. (the "Debtor"), seeking entry of an order authorizing the Debtor to reject certain executory contracts (collectively, the "Rejected Contracts"); it appearing that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor's estate, its creditors and other parties-in-interest; the Court having reviewed the Motion and having considered the statements of counsel and evidence adduced with respect to the Motion at a hearing before the Court (the "Hearing"); the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), (c) it appearing that venue of this proceeding and this Motion in this District is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and

1409 and (d) due and proper notice of this Motion having been provided; and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED**

- 1. The Motion is granted rejecting those executor contracts included on Exhibit 1, except for that certain executor contract with Cinema Scene.
- 2. Hearing on the rejection of the executory contract between Debtor and Cinema Scene will be and it is hereby adjourned to November 5, 2012 at 10:00 a.m.
- 3. The Debtor is authorized and empowered to take all actions necessary to effectuate the relief granted pursuant to this Order in accordance with the Motion.
- 4. Each Rejected Contracted listed on Exhibit 1 to this Order, except for that certain executory contract with Cinema Scene, is rejected effective as of fourteen (14) days from entry of this Order.
- 5. The Debtor shall provide prompt written notice to each counterparty to the Rejected Contracts of the effective date of the rejection of its Rejected Contract.
- 6. Each counterparty to the Rejected Contract shall have thirty (30) days after the entry of this Order to submit any claims arising from the rejection of the Rejected Contracts and if such counterparties fail to timely to file such claims, they shall be barred from receiving any distribution or dividend from the Debtor's estate.
- 7. Notwithstanding the possible applicability of Bankruptcy Rules 6004(g), 7062, 9014 or otherwise, the terms and conditions of this Order shall be immediately effective and enforceable upon its entry.
- 8. The Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or relating to the implementation of this Order.
