**ORDER AUTHORIZING, PURSUANT TO SECTION 105(A), DEBTOR TO
CONTINUE ITS PRE-PETITION CUSTOMER PROGRAMS**

Upon the Motion dated September 21, 2012 (the "Motion") (Docket No. 10), of Dickinson Theatres, Inc., (the "Debtor"), for an order authorizing it, pursuant to Section 105(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, to continue its pre-petition customer programs; and notice of the Motion having been provided to the United States Trustee for the District of Kansas, the Debtor's secured creditors and its twenty largest unsecured creditors; and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and the Court having determined that the relief sought in the Motion is in the best interest of the Debtor, its creditors and all parties-in-interest; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby:

ORDERED that Debtor is authorized to continue its Customer Programs in the ordinary course of its business, as set forth in the Motion, in the same manner and on the same basis as the Debtor implemented and maintained such policies and programs prior to the commencement of this Chapter 11 proceeding; it is further

ORDERED that the Debtor is authorized to honor all pre-petition obligations relating to its Customer Programs, as set forth in the Motion, in the ordinary course of its business, in the same manner and on the same basis as the Debtor honored such obligations prior to the commencement of its Chapter 11 case; provided, however, that the relief granted herein shall not constitute an approval or assumption of any Customer Program or related agreement or policy pursuant to Section 365 of the Bankruptcy Code; it is further

ORDERED that cause exists to waive the mandatory 21-day notice required by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6003 in order to avoid immediate and irreparable harm to the Debtor's estate; and it is further

ORDERED that cause exists to waive the mandatory 14-day stay required by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 6004(h).


