**ORDER SUSTAINING DEBTOR'S OBJECTION TO CLAIM #14 FILED BY
BUILDERS EQUIPMENT & TOOL COMPANY D/B/A BETCO SCAFFOLDS
AS CLAIM #14 HAS BEEN SATISFIED IN FULL POST-PETITION**

Upon the Objection filed by Dickinson Theatres, Inc. ("Debtor"), to Claim #14 of Builders Equipment & Tool Company d/b/a Betco Scaffolds ("Claimant") in the case of Dickinson Theatres, Inc., Case No. 12-22602, this matter comes on before this Court. 
