**ORDER GRANTING TRUSTEE'S APPLICATION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER  
AUTHORIZING THE EMPLOYMENT OF KAPILAMUKAMAL, LLP AS FORENSIC  
ACCOUNTANTS FOR THE TRUSTEE NUNC PRO TUNC TO MAY 1, 2014 [Doc. 1018]**

THIS MATTER came before the Court without a hearing on the *Application For Entry Of An Order Authorizing The Employment Of KapilaMukamal, LLP As Forensic Accountants For The Trustee Nunc Pro Tunc To May 1, 2014* [Doc. 1018] (the "Employment Application") filed by ROBERT E. TARDIF, JR. (the "Trustee"), as Chapter 7 Trustee for the substantively consolidated bankruptcy estates of ULRICH FELIX ANTON ENGLER, PRIVATE COMMERCIAL OFFICE, INC., and PCO CLIENT MANAGEMENT, INC. (collectively, the "Debtors").

The Court, being familiar with the record of this bankruptcy case, having reviewed the Employment Application, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, does hereby

ORDER as follows:

1. The Employment Application is GRANTED *nunc pro tunc* to May 1, 2014.
2. None of the disclosures or representations set forth in the Verified Statement of Soneet R. Kapila in support of the Employment Application constitutes a conflict of interest or impairs the disinterestedness of KapilaMukamal, LLP ("KM") or otherwise precludes the Trustee's employment of KM in this case.

3. The Trustee is authorized to employ KM as forensic accountants and KM is authorized to render professional services to the Trustee in accordance with the Employment Application.

4. KM shall apply for compensation for professional services rendered and reimbursement of expenses incurred in connection with the Debtors' Chapter 7 case in compliance with the applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules, the Local Rules, guidelines established by the Office of the United States Trustee for the Middle District of Florida and any other applicable procedures and orders of the Court.

5. The terms of the Order granting the Trustee's *Application To Employ Accountant* (Doc. 90) shall continue to apply to services rendered by Kapila & Company in the period March 31, 2008 through April 30, 2014.
