**SECOND MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR TRUSTEE AND  
CREDITORS TO OBJECTION TO DEBTOR'S DISCHARGE  
OR THE DISCHARGEABILITY OF DEBTS**

COMES NOW the Trustee, ROBERT E. TARDIF JR., and moves the Court to extend the deadline for the Trustee and Creditors to object to the Debtor's discharge or the dischargeability to debts and states as follows:

1. On March 31, 2008, an involuntary petition was filed against the Debtor and an Order for Relief was entered on April 29, 2008.
2. The deadline to file an objection to the Debtor's discharge was previously extended to December 29, 2008.
3. The Debtor appears to be a fugitive from justice and has not appeared for a creditors meeting to be examined by the Trustee.
4. The Trustee believes the deadline for filing objections to the Debtor's discharge and/or the dischargeability of debts should be extended. The Trustee suggests that the Court extend the deadline indefinitely to 90 days after the Debtor attends a Section 341 meeting of creditors or, in the alternative, through March 31, 2009.

WHEREFORE the Trustee requests that the Court enter an Order extending the deadline to file objections to the Debtor's discharge and to the dischargeability as suggested above.
