AGREED ORDER GRANTING MANFRED U. WALCH, SIMONE WALCH, ALEXANDER WALCH, ISABELLA WALCH, SEBASTIAN WALCH, PATRICK SAAR, AND BEATRICE BEYERSDOERFER'S JOINDER IN EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO TRUSTEE'S OBJECTIONS TO PROOF OF CLAIM AND CONTINUE TO JULY 9, 2015 THE HEARING ON CLAIMS OBJECTIONS FOR MANFRED U. WALCH, SIMONE WALCH, ALEXANDER WALCH, ISABELLA WALCH, SEBASTIAN WALCH, PATRICK SAAR, AND BEATRICE BEYERSDOERFER

THIS MATTER came before the Court upon the *Joinder to Trustee's Agreed Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to Trustee's Objections to Proof of Claim Numbers 64 through 69, 443, 444, and 493 Filed in the Engler Bankruptcy Case and Continue to July 9, 2015 the Hearing on the Group Claims Objections* (the "Agreed Motion") [ECF# 1077] filed by Manfred U. Walch, Simone Walch, Alexander Walch, Isabella Walch, Sebastian Walch, Patrick Saar, and Beatrice Beyersdoerfer (the "Joinder") [ECF# 1086]. The Court, having considered the Joinder and the Agreed Motion, and finding good cause for relief sought therein, **ORDERS** as follows:

1. The Agreed Motion and Joinder are **GRANTED** as to the following Claimants'
 - a. Manfred U. Walch;
 - b. Simone Walch;
 - c. Alexander Walch;
 - d. Isabella Walch;
 - e. Sebastian Walch;
 - f. Patrick Saar; and
 - g. Beatrice Beyersdoerfer

(collectively, the "Claimants").

2. The Claimants shall have an additional 30 days, until May 26, 2015, to respond to the Trustee's Objection to their respective claims.

3. The Hearing on the *Trustee's Objection to Claim of Congro Finanz, AG (Claim No. 68)* [ECF# 1054] and the *Response to Trustee's Objection to Claim of Congro Finanz, AG (Claim No. 68)* filed by Manfred Walch and Simons Walch [ECF# 1062] is rescheduled to **Thursday, July 16, 2015 at 9:30 a.m.** at the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, Sam M. Gibbons United States Courthouse, 801 North Florida Avenue, Courtroom 8A, Tampa, Florida 33602.

4. The relief granted in this Order is without prejudice to the Trustee seeking further continuance of the Hearing or extension of the deadline to respond to the Trustee's Objection to Claims by agreement or otherwise.
