**AGREED ORDER SUSTAINING-IN-PART AND OVERRULING-IN-PART TRUSTEE'S
OBJECTIONS TO CLAIM OF CONGRO FINANZ, AG [CLAIM NO. 68] [ECF# 1054]**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon the *Trustee's Objection to Claim of Congro Finanz, AG [Claim Number 68]* (the "Objection") [ECF# 1054] and Responses filed by Patrick Saar ("Saar") [ECF# 1096], (the "Response").
