**ORDER GRANTING WELLS FARGO BANK, N.A.'S MOTION TO LIMIT SERVICE FOR CREDITORS AND PARTIES IN INTEREST PURSUANT TO SAME TERMS APPROVED FOR TRUSTEE BY ORDER GRANTING TRUSTEE'S MOTION TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN NOTICE, CASE MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES [ECF No. 1115]**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court, without a hearing, upon the Motion To Limit Service for Creditors and Parties in Interest Pursuant to Same Terms Approved for Trustee by Order Granting Trustee's Motion to Establish Certain Notice, Case Management And Administrative Procedures filed by the Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. ("Wells Fargo") [ECF No. 1115]. The Court, having reviewed the motion and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, does hereby,

ORDER AND ADJUDGE as follows:

1. Wells Fargo's Motion [ECF No. 1115] is GRANTED.

2. The terms of the Order Granting Trustee's Motion to Establish Certain Notice, Case Management and Administrative Procedures [ECF No. 451] ("Notice Order") apply to service of documents in the main bankruptcy case by creditors and parties in interest. Specifically, the applicable Case Management Procedures as referenced in the Notice Order are approved as follows:

a. Creditors and Parties in Interest, including Wells Fargo, are authorized to limit service of the Documents by establishing a core group of entities to receive notice of all Documents filed in the main bankruptcy case. The core group shall include: (a) the Debtors and their counsel (if any); (b) the Office of the United States Trustee for the Middle District of Florida; (c) the Trustee and his counsel; and (d) any party with a particularized interest in the particular relief at issue (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Core Group").

b. All other parties in interest may obtain service of the Documents by filing a notice of appearance and request for service pursuant to Rule 2002 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure (hereinafter "CM/ECF") and that such service shall be deemed sufficient for all purposes. Any party filing a notice of appearance and request for service that does not maintain and cannot practically obtain an e-mail address must include in its notice of appearance a certification to that effect. Notice will be provided to such parties by first class mail or facsimile.

c. The Trustee has established the website <http://www.englerbk.com> for the general public to access without charge to review and, if appropriate, download Documents filed in the main bankruptcy case within five business days of filing.

Attorney Heather L. Ries is directed to serve a copy of this order on interested parties who are non-CM/ECF users and to file a proof of service within three days of entry of the order.
