**AGREED ORDER SUSTAINING IN PART AND OVERRULING IN PART TRUSTEE'S
OBJECTION TO CLAIM OF PRIMUS GMBH (CLAIM NUMBER 67) AS TO CLAIMS
OF ANDREAS BERNER**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon the *Trustee's Objection to Claim of Primus GmbH [Claim Number 67]* [ECF No. 1059] (the "Objection") filed by certain individual investors who filed Proof of Claim Number 67 (the "Group Claim"). The Court, having considered the Objection, finding that service of the Objection was proper under Bankruptcy Rule 3007 and Local Bankruptcy Rule 3007-1(b), and noting the agreement of the Trustee and Mr. Andreas Berner, through his counsel, to treat his portion of the Group Claim as set forth

herein, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Objection as to the individual claims of Andreas Berner is sustained in part and overruled in part.

2. Andreas Berner shall have a single allowed general unsecured claim in the amount of \$365,320.00 for Group Claim Control Nos. 67.51, 67.52, 67.53, 67.54, 67.55, 67.56 and 67.57.

3. The Court reserves jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this order.
