

**AGREED ORDER SUSTAINING-IN-PART AND OVERRULING-IN-PART
TRUSTEE'S OBJECTION TO CLAIM OF HELMUT BEIER [CLAIM NO. 628]
[ECF NO. 1130]**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon the *Trustee's First Omnibus Objection to Claims (Claimant Names Beginning With "A" and "B")* (the "Objection") [ECF No. 1133], Claim Number 628 filed by Helmut Beier and the Response to the Objection filed by Helmut Beier [ECF No. 1295] (the "Response"). The Court has considered the Objection, the Claim, the Response and the agreement of the Trustee to treat the Claim in the amount requested by the claimant in the Response. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS and ADJUDGES** as follows:

1. The Objection is **SUSTAINED-IN-PART** and **OVERRULED-IN-PART** as follows:

- a. Claim Number 628 is allowed as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$122,000.00.

2. The Court reserves the jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this order.
