**AGREED ORDER SUSTAINING-IN-PART AND OVERRULING-IN-PART
TRUSTEE'S OBJECTION TO CLAIM OF WOLFGANG DOBLER [CLAIM NO. 625]
[ECF NO. 1131]**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon the *Trustee's Second Omnibus Objection to Claims (Claimant Names Beginning With "C", "D" and "E")* (the "Objection") [ECF No. 1131], Claim Number 625 filed by Wolfgang Dobler and the Response to the Objection filed by Wolfgang Dobler [ECF No. 1199] (the "Response"). The Court has considered the Objection, the Claim, the Response and the agreement of the parties to treat the Claim as set forth herein. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS and ADJUDGES** as follows:

1. The Objection is **SUSTAINED-IN-PART** and **OVERRULED-IN-PART** as follows:

a. Claim Number 625 is allowed as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$400,000.00.

2. The Court reserves the jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this order.
