**ORDER SUSTAINING TRUSTEE'S OBJECTION TO CLAIMS OF PETER LECHNER
[CLAIM NOS. 527 AND 557] [ECF NO. 1135]**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon the *Trustee's Sixth Omnibus Objection to Claims (Claimant Names Beginning With "L" and "M")* (the "Objection") [ECF No. 1135], Claim Numbers 527 and 557 filed by Peter Lechner and the Certificate of No Response or Settlement [ECF No. 1428] (the "Certificate"), and the Court, having considered the Objection and the Certificate, and due and proper notice of the Objection having been provided to the parties listed in the Proof of Service [ECF No. 1147] and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and the Court having reviewed the Objection and determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Objection establish just cause for the relief granted

herein and upon all of the proceedings had before the Court and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, the Court **ORDERS and ADJUDGES** as follows:

1. The Objection is **SUSTAINED** as follows:
 - a. Claim Number 527 is allowed as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$14,375.00; and
 - b. Claim Number 557 is allowed as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$22,000.00.
2. The Court reserves the jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this order.
