**ORDER SUSTAINING-IN-PART AND OVERRULING-IN-PART  
TRUSTEE'S OBJECTION TO CLAIMS OF MARIANNE STOCKINGER  
[CLAIM NOS. 568 & 594] [ECF NO. 1138]**

**THIS CAUSE** having come before the Court upon the *Trustee's Ninth Omnibus Objection to Claims (Claimant Names Beginning With "S")* (the "Objection") [ECF No. 1138], Claim Numbers 568 and 594 filed by Marianne Stockinger and the Response to the Objection filed by Marianne Stockinger [ECF No. 1382] (the "Response"). The Court has considered the Objection, the Claims, the Response and the agreement of the Trustee to treat the Claims in the amount requested by the claimant in the Response. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS and ADJUDGES** as follows:

1. The Objection is **SUSTAINED-IN-PART** and **OVERRULED-IN-PART** as follows:

- a. Claim Number 568 is allowed as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$10,000.00; and
- b. Claim Number 594 is allowed as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$10,000.00.

2. The Court reserves the jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this order.
