**ORDER SUSTAINING-IN-PART AND OVERRULING-IN-PART
TRUSTEE'S OBJECTION TO CLAIMS OF MARTIN HEIDRICHS
[CLAIM NOS. 360, 455 AND 966] [ECF NO. 1133]**

THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon the *Trustee's Fourth Omnibus Objection to Claims (Claimant Names Beginning With "H" and "I")* (the "Objection") [ECF No. 1133], Claim Numbers 360, 455 and 966 filed by Martin Heidrichs and the Response to the Objection filed by Martin Heidrichs [ECF No. 1405] (the "Response"). The Court has considered the Objection, the Claims, the Response and the agreement of the Trustee to treat the Claims in the amount requested by the claimant in the Response. Accordingly, the Court **ORDERS and ADJUDGES** as follows:

1. The Objection is **SUSTAINED-IN-PART** and **OVERRULED-IN-PART** as follows:

- a. Claim Number 360 is stricken and disallowed in its entirety; and
- b. Claim Number 455 is allowed as a general unsecured claim in the amount of \$100,000.00; and
- c. Claim Number 966 is stricken and disallowed in its entirety.

2. The Court reserves the jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this order.
