

ORDER ON APPLICATION TO EMPLOY AUCTIONEER

This cause came on for consideration, without hearing, upon the Application to Employ Auctioneer (Doc. No. 1430) in the above captioned case. The Court has considered the Application, together with the record, and finds that the Application seeks to employ BAY AREA AUCTION SERVICES, INC., as Auctioneer for the Trustee. As no notice of hearing on the Application should be given and this Court is satisfied that the above-named auctioneer represents no adverse interest to the Debtor in the matters upon which they are to be retained, that the employment is necessary and would be in the best interest of the estate, and that the case is one justifying the employment of said auctioneer, the Application to Employ Auctioneer, therefore, should be approved. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Application be and the same is hereby approved. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Trustee is hereby authorized to employ BAY AREA AUCTION SERVICES, INC. as Auctioneer and to pay the auctioneer a reasonable fee of ten percent (10%) plus documented expenses, upon Application and Order by this Court.
