

**ORDER SUSTAINING TRUSTEE'S OBJECTION TO CLAIM OF CHRISTINE &
FRANK HILLER [CLAIM NO. 22]
[ECF NO. 1470]**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon the *Trustee's Objection to Claim of Christine & Frank Hiller* (the "Objection") [ECF No. 1470] and Claim Number 22 filed by Christine and Frank Hiller. The Court, having considered the Objection and the Claim, finding that service of the Objection was proper under Bankruptcy Rule 3007 and Local Bankruptcy Rule 3007-1(b) and noting that the claimants have not responded to the Objection, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, it is **ORDERED and ADJUDGED** as follows:

1. The Objection is **SUSTAINED** as follows:

- a. Claim Number 22 is stricken and disallowed in its entirety as being duplicative of portions of Claim 67.
2. The Court reserves the jurisdiction to enforce the terms of this order.
