THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon the Expedited Motion For Authorization To Incur Expenses For Travel Of German Witnesses And German Interpreter In Connection With Evidentiary Hearing On The Motion To Substantively Consolidate Non-Debtor Douglas Investments, LLC With And Into The Debtors' Bankruptcy Estates filed by ROBERT E. TARDIF, JR., as the Chapter 7 Trustee for the substantively consolidated bankruptcy estates of Ulrich Felix Anton Engler, Private Commercial Office, Inc., and PCO Client Management, Inc. (hereinafter the "Trustee") [D.E. 389] (the "Motion for Authorization"). The Court, having reviewed the motion and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, does hereby

And Into The Debtors' Bankruptcy Estates [D.E. 212] as well as the associated expense of a German translator.
