**ORDER STRIKING MOTION TO ALLOW UNITED STATES  
BANKRUPTCY COURT JUDGES ALEXANDER L. PASKAY  
AND MICHAEL G. WILLIAMSON TO JOINTLY PRESIDE  
OVER FINAL EVIDENTIARY HEARING ON JUNE 17, 2010**

THIS CASE came on for consideration without a hearing on the Motion to Allow United States Bankruptcy Court Judges Alexander L. Paskay and Michael G. Williamson to Jointly Preside over Final Evidentiary Hearing on June 17, 2010 (Doc. No. 398) (“Motion”), filed by Fidelity National Timber Resources, Inc. f/k/a Fidelity National Ranch Properties, Inc., and Fidelity National Financial, Inc. Assignment of cases is within the province of the Clerk and the Chief Judge, as provided in Bankr. M.D. Fla.
