**TRUSTEE'S MOTION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO POST
ATTORNEY FEE DEPOSITS IN CONNECTION WITH EUROPEAN LITIGATION**

COMES NOW the Trustee, ROBERT E. TARDIF JR., and moves the Court to grant him authority to post required attorneys fee deposits in connection with litigation in Germany and states as follows:

1. The Trustee has filed various legal actions to avoid fraudulent transfers in Germany.
2. Pursuant to German law/rule, the Trustee has been requested to post a required deposit for attorney's fees.
3. Pursuant to the request the Trustee is seeking authorization to post two deposits in the approximate amount of \$98,000 Euro, which at current exchange rates is approximately \$125,000.00 U.S. dollars.
4. The claims at issue total approximately \$300,000.00 U.S. dollars. If the Trustee prevails, the Trustee would expect the return of the deposits.
5. The Trustee currently has on hand sufficient funds to make the deposits.

WHEREFORE the Trustee moves the Court to authorize the Trustee to post the deposits.
