
ORDER ON APPLICATION TO EMPLOY COUNSEL

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration *ex parte* upon an Application to Employ Counsel filed by the Trustee in the above-captioned Chapter 7 case. ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Trustee be, and he is hereby authorized to employ Miller & Hollander, P.A., under a general retainer and to the amount of compensation of counsel shall be determined by Order of this Court upon properly submitted application for allowance filed in compliance with Bankruptcy Rule 2016.
