

**ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO EMPLOY SPECIAL COUNSEL**

This cause came on for consideration *ex parte* upon an Application to Employ Special Counsel filed by the Trustee herein. The Court has considered the Application, together with the record, and finds that the Application seeks to employ Karl Becker, as counsel for the Trustee, for the prosecution of fraudulent transfer litigation and other related litigation in Germany and to administer assets of this estate and other actions that may arise in this bankruptcy case.
