ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO


The Court considered the record and finds that the Application warrants the entry of an Order requiring a response from the Debtor, pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9014, in order to expeditiously dispose of this matter. Therefore, it is appropriate to direct the Debtor to file a written response within twenty-one (21) days from the date of entry of this Order. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Debtor is directed to file a written response to the Application within twenty-one (21) days from the date of entry of this Order and to serve a copy of said response upon the applicant and its attorney.
2. If the Debtor fails to timely file a written response, the Court will consider the Application ex parte and enter the appropriate order upon submission by the moving party.
