**ORDER ON TRUSTEE'S APPLICATION FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES TO
TRUSTEE AND TO PAY ATTORNEY'S FEES
IN FRAUDULENT TRANSFER ACTION**

(DOC. NO. 698)

THIS CAUSE came on before the Court, without a hearing, upon the Trustee's Application for Reimbursement of Expenses to Trustee and to Pay Attorney's Fees in Fraudulent Transfer Action, and the Court having reviewed the Application together with invoices, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, finds that the Trustee should be authorized reimbursement for expenses and costs that were paid by the Trustee in order to preserve assets of the estate. The Court also finds that the Trustee should be authorized to pay attorney's fees to opposing counsel in a fraudulent transfer action, and it is, therefore

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that Robert E Tardif Jr., Trustee in Bankruptcy, be and he is hereby authorized \$18,370.69 as reimbursement for payment of utilities, property taxes, and property insurance paid in this matter. It is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Trustee is hereby authorized to pay attorney's fees to opposing counsel in the amount of 5,067.02€
