

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**ORDER GRANTING TRUSTEE'S *EXPEDITED* MOTION FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER  
CONFIRMING HIS AUTHORITY TO ACT IN A FOREIGN COUNTRY  
ON BEHALF OF THE DEBTORS' BANKRUPTCY ESTATES  
*NUNC PRO TUNC TO THE PETITION DATE PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 1505***

THIS MATTER came before the Court for a hearing on October 20, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. on the *Expedited* Motion For Entry Of An Order Confirming [the Trustee's] Authority To Act In A Foreign Country On Behalf Of The Debtors' Bankruptcy Estates *Nunc Pro Tunc* To The Petition Date pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1505 [D.E. 744] (the "Motion to Confirm the Trustee's Authority") filed by Robert E. Tardif, Jr. (the "Trustee"), as Chapter 7 Trustee of the substantively consolidated bankruptcy estates of Ulrich Felix Anton Engler, Private Commercial Office, Inc., and PCO Client Management, Inc. (collectively, the "Debtors"). The Court, having reviewed the Motion to Confirm the Trustee's Authority as well as the record of this bankruptcy case, having heard argument by Special Counsel for the Trustee, being otherwise duly advised in the premises, and for the reasons stated orally and recorded in open Court, which shall constitute the decision of this Court, does hereby

ORDER as follows:

1. The Motion to Confirm the Trustee's Authority is GRANTED.

2. The Court hereby confirms that the Trustee Robert E. Tardif, Jr. was authorized to act on behalf of Debtors Ulrich Felix Anton Engler, Private Commercial Office, Inc., and PCO Client Management, Inc., individually or collectively, in any and all foreign countries (e.g., Germany, France, Switzerland, Liechtenstein, and Luxembourg), pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1505 from March 31, 2008 through the present day.

3. At all relevant times, the Trustee was (and continues to be) authorized to take all actions deemed necessary or appropriate in order to recover assets for the Debtors' bankruptcy estates including, by way of example and not by way of limitation, filing and prosecuting lawsuits to avoid and to recover fraudulent or preferential transfers of the Debtors' assets to third parties.

4. All prior orders of this Court shall have the same force and effect as if this Order granting the Motion to Confirm the Trustee's Authority was entered on March 31, 2008
