**ORDER ON MOTION FOR AUTHORITY TO COMPROMISE  
CONTROVERSY WITH CESAR BOBADILLA (DOC. 920)**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court without hearing upon the Trustee's Motion for Authority to Compromise Controversy with Cesar Bobadilla (Doc. 920), and the Court having reviewed the record and finding that the only objection filed to the Trustee's motion has been withdrawn, and the Court finding that the motion is well taken, and it is in the best interest of the bankruptcy estate that the Trustee be authorized to compromise the controversy by Cesar Bobadilla purchasing all artwork recovered by the Federal Bureau of Investigation from the Debtor in Las Vegas, Nevada for the sum of \$140,000.00. It is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Trustee's Motion is hereby granted, and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Trustee is hereby authorized to settle the above any and all disputes with Cesar Bobadilla by Cesar Bobadilla purchasing all artwork recovered by the Federal Bureau of Investigation from the Debtor in Las Vegas, Nevada for the sum of \$140,000.

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Trustee is hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to consummate the settlement.
