**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO MODIFY ORDER


Having considered the law, the Motion to Modify, the *Response and Reservation of
Rights to the Motion to Modify Order Authorizing the Continued Employment and Retention of
FTI Consulting, Inc. as Financial Advisors to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors*
(P-1189), the lack of any objection to the Motion to Modify and the arguments of counsel and
sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion to Modify is **GRANTED**; it is further

ORDERED that the *Order Authorizing Retention of FTI Consulting, Inc as Financial Advisors for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors* (P-284), the *Order Authorizing the Continued Employment and Retention of FTI Consulting, Inc. as Financial Advisors to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors* (P-581) and the *Order Modifying the Order Authorizing the Continued Employment and Retention of FTI Consulting, Inc. as Financial Advisors to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors* (P-998) (the “Compensation Orders”) are modified retroactively to remove any limitation on the compensation of FTI Consulting, Inc. or reimbursement of expenses of FTI Consulting, Inc. during this bankruptcy case; it is further

ORDERED that other than the removal of any limitation of compensation or reimbursement contained in the Compensation Orders, the compensation of FTI Consulting, Inc. remains subject to the procedures set forth in Sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code, Bankruptcy Court approval, and the *Order Granting Motion for an Administrative Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Professionals and Committee Members* (P-27).
