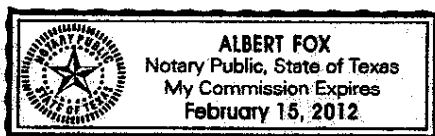

1. By Order dated March 8, 2010, (the "Disclosure Statement Order"), the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division (the "Court") approved the Disclosure Statement Pursuant to Section 1125 of the Bankruptcy Code with Respect to the Debtors' Fourth Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (the "Plan") for Erickson Retirement Communities LLC and its affiliated Debtors (including all exhibits thereto and as amended, modified or supplemented from time to time, the "Disclosure Statement") as containing adequate information within the meaning of section 1125 of chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code").

2. By the Disclosure Statement Order, the Court established April 8, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time) and April 13, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time) (for STAMPS Holders) (collectively, the "Voting Deadline") as the deadline by which ballots accepting or rejecting the Plan must be received. To be counted, your original ballot must actually be received on or before the Voting Deadline by BMC Group, Inc. at the following addresses:

3. On April 15, 2010 at 2:30 p.m. (prevailing Central Time), or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, a hearing will be held before the Honorable Stacy G. C. Jernigan in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, 1100 Commerce Street, 14th Floor, Room 1424, Courtroom #1 to consider confirmation of the Plan, as the same may be amended or modified (the "Plan Confirmation Hearing"). The Plan Confirmation Hearing may be adjourned from time to time, without further notice.

4. The Plan may be modified in accordance with the Bankruptcy Code², the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Plan and other applicable law, without further notice, prior to or as a result of the Plan Confirmation Hearing.

5. Objections, if any, to confirmation of the Plan, including any supporting memoranda, must be in writing, be filed with the Clerk of the Court, United States Bankruptcy Court, Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, 1100 Commerce Street, Room 1254, Dallas, Texas 75242-1496 together with proof of service on or before April 9, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. (prevailing Central Time) (the "Objection Deadline"), and shall (a) state the name and address of the objecting party and the amount of its claim or the nature of its interest in the Debtors' chapter 11 cases; (b) state with particularity the provision or provisions of the Plan objected to and for any objection asserted, the legal and factual basis for such objections; and (c) be served upon: (i) counsel for the Debtors: DLA Piper LLP (US), 1251 Avenue of the Americas, New York, New York 10020-1104, Attn: Thomas R.
