MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING

The Debtors and Debtors in Possession herein (collectively, the “Debtors”), by their undersigned counsel, hereby file this motion (the “Motion”) to continue the hearing set for April

27, 2010 on Debtors' Amended Motion for Determination of Tax Liability [Doc. No. 1287] (the "Tax Motion"), and respectfully state as follows:

1. On October 19, 2009 (the "Petition Date"), the Debtors commenced these cases by each filing voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.

2. The Debtors remain in possession of their assets and continue to operate and manage their businesses as debtors in possession pursuant to Bankruptcy Code sections 1107 and 1108.

3. On November 2, 2009, the Office of the United States Trustee appointed a committee of unsecured creditors in these cases. No trustee or examiner has been appointed.

4. On April 9, 2010, the Debtors filed the Tax Motion. A hearing on the Tax Motion is set for April 27, 2010 at 1:30 p.m.

5. The Debtors and the local taxing authorities are working towards a resolution of the Debtors' objections raised and the relief sought in the Tax Motion related to the valuations of the Debtors' properties and the related taxes. The Debtors feel that some or all of the issues raised in the Tax Motion may be resolved without adjudication by the Court. Therefore, the Debtors request that the hearing on the Tax Motion be continued and reset for June 3, 2010 at 9:30 a.m.

6. The Debtors also request that the Court set the uniform response date to the Tax Motion as May 27, 2010.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Debtors request that this Court (i) grant the relief requested in the Motion, (ii) continue the hearing on the Tax Motion to June, 3 2010 at 9:30 a.m., (iii) set the uniform response date to the Tax Motion as May 27, 2010; and (iv) grant the Debtors such other and further relief, both at law and in equity, which is just and proper.
