Application of Bracewell & Giuliani LLP, Counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors, for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for the Period November 2, 2009 Through March 31, 2010 (the "<u>B&G Application</u>") [Dkt. No. 1421] and (b) the First and Final Fee Application of Protiviti Inc. for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses as Financial Advisors for the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors for the Period Nunc Pro Tunc from November 4, 2009 Through March 31, 2010 (the "<u>Protiviti Application</u>") [Dkt. No. 1422], and respectfully states as follows:

#### **Background**

1. On October 19, 2009 (the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), the Debtors commenced these cases by each filing voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.

2. The Debtors remained in possession of their assets and continued to operate and manage their businesses as debtors in possession during the bankruptcy proceedings pursuant to Bankruptcy Code sections 1107 and 1108.

3. On November 2, 2009, the Office of the United States Trustee appointed a committee of unsecured creditors in these cases. No trustee or examiner has been appointed.

4. On April 30, 2010, Bracewell & Giuliani LLP filed the B&G Application. A hearing thereon is scheduled for July 15, 2010 at 9:30 a.m. Also on April 30, 2010, Protiviti Inc. filed the Protiviti Application. A hearing thereon is also scheduled for July 15, 2010 at 9:30 a.m.

5. DLA Piper will shortly file its final application for compensation and reimbursement of expenses, as counsel to the Debtors (the "DLA Application"). DLA Piper has requested that the DLA Application be heard on July 15, 2010 at 2:30 p.m. It is expected that Alvarez & Marsal Healthcare Industry Group LLC ("<u>A&M</u>") will also shortly file its first and

final application for compensation and reimbursement of expenses (the "<u>A&M" Application</u>"). The hearing date of July 15, 2010 is also agreeable to A&M. However, because professionals will be flying into Dallas from other locations to attend the hearing, it is requested that the hearing be scheduled for 2:30 p.m. on that day, rather than 9:30 a.m.

6. Counsel for the Debtors have contacted Bracewell & Giuliani and Protiviti on this matter. Bracewell & Giuliani has consented to the relief requested herein. Counsel has not yet heard back from Protiviti. However, in view of the convenience that a later hearing time offers to all concerned, counsel submits that it is likely that Protiviti, upon being contacted, will consent as well.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Debtors request that this Court (i) continue the hearing on the B&G Application and the Protiviti Application to July 15, 2010 at 2:30 p.m. and (ii) grant the Debtors such other and further relief, both at law and in equity, which is just and proper.
