Please be advised that John Fox filed an individual Chapter 7 bankruptcy case on February 8, 2016. Mr. Fox's bankruptcy case is pending in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of California as Case No. 16-40340 WJL 7.

Your filing of the small claims action against Mr. Fox violates the automatic stay of 11 U.S.C. § 362.
