- 7. On or about October 23, 2015, the Debtor transferred \$78,736.33 of its funds to Defendant Shirlin Wong (the "Defendant"). A true and correct copy of the check from the Debtor to Defendant is attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Transfer").
- The Debtor made the Transfer to or for the benefit of a creditor, namely the 8. Defendant, who at the time of the Transfer was owed money by the Debtor.
  - The Transfer was made on account of an antecedent debt... 9.
  - The Transfer was made while the Debtor was insolvent. 10.
  - 11. The Transfer was made within 90 days of the Petition Date.
- The Transfer enabled Defendant to receive more than she would have received if: 12. (a) the case was a case under chapter 7 of Title 11; (b) the Debtor had not made the Transfer; and (c) Defendant received payment of such debt to the extent provided by the provisions of Title 11.
- The Defendant asserted dominion and control of the funds transferred and the 13. Defendant was the initial transferee of the Transfer under 11 U.S.C. §550(a)(1).
- The Trustee's investigation is ongoing and to the extent the Trustee discovers 14. additional transfers to Defendant within the 90 day period prior to the Petition Date, the Trustee will amend this complaint to include such transfers as part of this claim.

WHEREFORE, the Trustee prays for relief as set forth below.
