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**ORDER APPROVING ASSUMPTION OF 1999 CHEVROLET SUBURBAN UNEXPIRED
LEASE AND AUTHORIZING DEBTORS TO EXERCISE
BUY OUT PROVISION CONTAINED WITHIN THE LEASE**

This matter having come before the Court upon the Debtors' Motion For Order Approving Assumption of 1999 Chevrolet Suburban Unexpired Lease and Authorizing Debtors to Exercise Buy Out Provision Contained Within the Lease (the "Motion"), and the Court finding that the relief requested by the Debtors is necessary and proper under the circumstances and is in the best interest of the estate; it is hereby

ORDERED that the Debtors are authorized to cure the amount due under the Lease, as defined in the Motion, in an amount up to \$2,562.50, pursuant to Section 365(b)(1); and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtors are authorized to assume the Lease, only to the extent it applies to the identified Schedule, as set forth and defined on the attached Exhibit A; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Debtors are authorized to exercise the buy out provision contained within the Lease in an amount up to \$2,499.99.
