ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM OR MODIFICATION OF AUTOMATIC STAY BY ALLIANCE PROCESS PARTNERS, L.L.C. d/b/a INTERNATIONAL ALLIANCE GROUP

THIS MATTER having come before the Court on the <u>Motion for Relief</u> from or <u>Modification of Automatic Stay</u> ("Motion") filed by Alliance Process Partners, L.L.C. d/b/a International Alliance Group ("IAG") and the Court having considered the Motion and the responses and objections filed with respect thereto, the arguments of counsel, and for good cause shown,

THE MOTION IS DENIED, without prejudice, for the following reasons:

- 1. The Court finds that the balance of equities weigh in favor of denial of the Motion;
- 2. The Debtors are in the process of preparing an omnibus procedure for addressing all mechanics' and artisan's liens in this Court and Debtors are entitled to a reasonable time to propose such a procedure, and
- 3. The Court is not persuaded by movant's argument that the value of the personal property at issue will be maximized by its removal from the Coffeyville facility. The Court finds that it is likely that the removal of the personal property would be to the detriment of the Debtors' estates and would result in a decrease in the value of the Coffeyville facility.
