4. The Debtors are authorized to use their existing business forms, letterhead and check stock, provided that the notations "debtor in possession" and "Case No. 12-44027-DML-11" are added to such forms, letterhead and check stock.

5. The Debtors are authorized to make investments in accordance with their prepetition investment practices.
