## Composition of the Initial Board of Directors and the Initial Senior Executive Officers of the Reorganized Debtors and Related Compensation Disclosure<sup>3</sup>

Pursuant to Section 6.3(f) of the Plan and section 1129(a)(5) of the Bankruptcy Code, and subject to confirmation of the Plan and occurrence of the Effective Date, this Plan Supplement sets forth the identities and affiliations of the initial board members and the initial senior executive officers of each Reorganized Debtor as of the Effective Date.

# Initial Members of the Boards of Directors of Reorganized FiberTower and the Reorganized FiberTower Subsidiaries

On the Effective Date, the boards of directors of Reorganized FiberTower and each of the Reorganized FiberTower Subsidiaries (the "Boards") shall initially be comprised of three (3) members, designated by the Ad Hoc 2016 Committee, and who shall include Craig Chobor, Neil Subin and John Dooley.

- 1. Craig Chobor. Mr. Chobor joined Solus Alternative Asset Management LP at its inception in July 2007, and has been a member of the hedge fund investment team since the funds' inceptions under the management of Stanfield Capital Partners. Mr. Chobor joined Stanfield in 1999 as a Credit Analyst covering retail, cable, euro cable, printing. publishing. television, radio. media. wireless. telecommunication. Mr. Chobor began his career at Scudder Kemper Investments in 1997 as a Senior Associate/Portfolio Assistant in the Emerging Markets Group. He is a Chartered Financial Analyst and is a member of the New York Society of Securities Analysts and the Association of Investment Management and Research. Mr. Chobor received a B.S. in Economics and International Business from the Pennsylvania State University in 1995, and an M.B.A. in Finance from Pace University in 2001.
- 2. <u>Neil Subin.</u> Mr. Subin has been the Chairman of the Board of Broadbill Investment Partners, LP, a private investment fund, since 2011. Since its formation in 1991, Mr. Subin has served as managing director and president of Trendex Capital Management, a private investment fund focusing primarily on financially distressed companies. Mr. Subin has served as a director of Institutional Financial Markets, Inc. since 2011, Phospate Holdings, Inc. since November 2010, Hancock Fabrics, Inc. since August 2009 and Federal-Mogul Corporation since December 2007.
- 3. <u>John Dooley</u>. Mr. Dooley is a recognized expert on wireless spectrum and the creator of revolutionary new spectrum applications like Terrestrial Low Power Service. In

his role as "spectrum scientist," Mr. Dooley has developed radical new methods for understanding the data carrying capacity of wireless spectrum that are transforming how the mobile industry values increasingly scarce radio-frequency resources. Mr. Dooley has extensive wireless technology engineering and regulatory experience. Mr. Dooley is the inventor of Nano Material Derived RF Conductive Polymers and founder of Nanoton, a company devoted to producing high performance filters for regulatory compliance. Mr. Dooley is the creator of the Terrestrial Low Power Service (TLPS), an innovative use of spectrum that led to the second FCC rule making process for satellite to terrestrial spectrum conversion in US history. Mr. Dooley is the Co-Founder and Managing Director of Jarvinian Ventures. Mr. Dooley is the inventor of more than 40 discrete wireless infrastructure innovations, with pioneer patents covering wireless antenna, filtration, spectrum analysis, and network intelligence technologies.
