The instructions and definitions below are general explanations of the law. In particular types of cases or circumstances such as bankruptcy cases that are not filed voluntarily by a debtor there may be exceptions to these general rules

Debtor	Secured Claim	Unsecured Claim
The person, corporation, or other entity that has filed a bankruptcy case is called the debtor	A claim is a secured claim to the extent that the creditor has a lien on property of the debtor (collateral) that gives the creditor the right to be paid from that property before creditors who do not have liens on the property	If a claim is not a secured claim it is an unsecured claim. A claim may be partly secured and partly unsecured if the property on which a creditor has a lien is not worth enough to pay the creditor in full
Creditor A creditor is any person, corporation, or other entity to whom the debtor owed a debt on the date the bankruptcy case was filed.	Examples of liens are a mortgage on real estate and a security interest in a car, truck, boat, television set or other item of property. A lien may have been obtained through a court proceeding before the bankruptcy case began, in some states a court judgment is a lien. In addition to the extent a creditor also owes money to be debtor (has a right of setoff), the creditor's claim may be a secured claim. (See also <i>Unsecured Claim</i>)	Unsecured Nonpriority Claim Certain types of unsecured claims are given priority, so they are to be paid in bankruptcy cases before most other unsecured claims (if there is sufficient money or property available to pay these claims). The most common types of priority claims are listed on the proof of claim form. Unsecured claims that are not specifically given priority status by the bankruptcy laws are classified as <i>Unsecured Nonpriority Claims</i> .
