

#### **C&S ACQUISITION PHYSICAL INVENTORY PROCEDURES**

This document identifies specific processes to be undertaken when conducting a physical count of merchandise inventories. Specific reports and screens referred to herein relate to the Fleming FOODS system, which operates at most of the divisions to be counted. Similar processes exist at other divisions.

#### Preparation

- 1. Determine the date(s) of the inventory counts.
- 2. Identify facilities and storage locations, where applicable, to be included in counts.
- 3. Establish schedules with third parties for audit and pallet counts, and with Fleming and C&S procurement teams for identification and segregation of unsaleable product.
- 4. Establish cutoff dates and times for all of the various transaction processes, including inventory in transit. Refer to sample memo from Distribution Manager.
- 5. Review facility reports, valuation basis (lot v last cost), and extensions.
- 6. Prepare communication to associates and retail customers.
- 7. Identify Fleming and C&S associates that will be participating in the process.
- 8. Print counts sheets, and assemble count books.
- 9. Print control logs (DSWI220-04)

#### **Pre-Inventory Meetings**

- 1. About one-half hour prior to the start of the counts, conduct a meeting with all counters, and review the pick, reserve, and write-in count sheets and instructions related to each. Refer to sample documents.
- 2. Identify control desk location(s) in the warehouse.
- 3. Identify roving supervisors for the counters, as well as the warehouse runners who will be carrying counts sheets from the control desk to the tabulation and data entry area.
- 4. Notify counters of break and lunch times.

#### **Counting Procedures**

Detailed counting procedures will be mutually agreed to no later than seven (7) days prior to a scheduled count and will include the following:

- 1. The inventory teams shall consist of Fleming associates, with assistance from C&S associates as deemed necessary by C&S.
- 2. Each warehouse control desk will be staffed by a Fleming, with assistance from C&S associates as deemed necessary by C&S. The control desk will be responsible for handing out count books to count teams. Each count team must sign for their book, and is responsible for returning the books.
- 3. Pick slots will be case counted (or each counted, for repack items). Each associate will make an independent count, and these will be compared in such instances where count teams are comprised of two counters. Any differences will result in both

- associates recounting until the counts agree. One associate will be responsible for recording the counts on the count sheets. Pick slot counts will be blind counts.
- 4. Reserve counts will be pallet specific verification, using the Fleming pallet tracking system.
- 5. Count teams will count one side of the aisle at a time, working from the bottom of the bay upward.
- 6. Upon completion of each book, return it to the control desk, and sign it back in. Another count book will be assigned.
- 7. The control desk will turn over completed books to the warehouse runner, who will transport the completed books to the tabulation and data entry area.

#### **Tabulation and Data Entry**

This process describes the steps involved in recording the counts in the system.

- 1. Each completed book will be tabulated for cases (and weights, for catchweight meat and deli) counted. Control hash totals are run on the count sheet line number. Run two balancing tapes on counts, (and weights, if applicable) and hash totals.
- 2. After tabulation is complete, forward the books to the data entry team. The team will enter the counts and the balancing totals on screen KINV. Any differences must be resolved. The system will not allow updates of count sheets that are out of balance.
- 3. After data entry is complete, place the count books in boxes, in zone number (book number) sequence.
- 4. The on-line system will identify any count sheets that are incomplete. These must be located and entered before the recount process can begin. When all books are accounted for, notify the appropriate I/T associates to print recount sheets.

#### **Recounts**

- 1. Recount sheets (WI261-01) reports will be run immediately following the first counts. Physical counts that result in a variance exceeding the perpetual file quantity by an amount equal to or greater than 10 cases or \$200.00 will result in that item being selected for recount.
- 2. Recounts are verification, but can be blind if the parties agree.
- 3. The control desk will hand out recount sheets to the count teams in the same manner as first count sheets. Report WI250-09, Physical Inventory Control Recounts Sheets, is used to track recount sheets.
- 4. The count teams will travel to the designated slot(s), and recount the item until they agree on a count.
- 5. Large variances may result in a different team being sent out for a third count.
- 6. The control desk will forward all recount sheets to the tabulation and data entry area, in the same manner as the initial count sheets.

#### Recount tabulation and data entry

- 1. The on-line system will identify any recount pages that are unaccounted for. These must be identified and entered before the process can move forward.
- 2. When all recounts are complete, assemble the recount pages in numerical order.
- 3. Notify I/T to finalize the inventory processes, and print the final reports.

#### **Physical Inventory Finalization**

The final inventory processing produces several reports; these are described below.

- 1. Physical Inventory Extension, (WI280-01). This is the "final" inventory extension, and is the report used to compare to the general ledger for calculating any gain or loss to be recorded. This report will be signed by both parties as agreement of the final physical counts. Any adjustments will be listed on the physical inventory reconciliation to the general ledger.
- 2. Physical Inventory Variance Report (WI281-01). This report will list variances from the final counts loaded and the perpetual file balance at the start of the counting process. It can be set to report a predetermined dollar or case variance. The standard variance reported is 10 cases or \$200.00. The report can be run in item code sequence, slot sequence, case adjustment sequence, dollar adjustment sequence, weight adjustment sequence (for weighted meat items), or merchandiser sequence. The dollar adjustment sequence is the most commonly used version. Fleming and C&S representatives, accompanied by a warehouse associate familiar with the facility, should use this report to attempt to identify any large discrepancies.
- 3. Physical Inventory Update Discrepancies (WI275-01). Provides a listing of items that were entered during the counts, but have a status of new, discontinued, or reinstated. These items are not added to the perpetual file when the inventory is updated. Any such items are to be manually costed, and manually added to the final inventory reconciliation. Fleming and C&S must come to an agreement as to the classification of any such items.

## **Calculation of Discounted Inventory**

The following are the steps to arrive at inventory valuation for items to be discounted:

Based on Seller's existing method of inventory classification as defined in the attached Exhibit, Purchaser shall apply the respective Valuation Factors as displayed in the subject exhibit.

# Calculation of Net Landed Cost in Accordance with Emerging Issues Task Force 02-16

The following process will be used in calculating the net landed cost adjustment of EITF 02-16:

The net landed cost or EITF 02-16 adjustment percentage, ("EITF Precent") will be 2.6%. The EITF Percent will be subtracted from the inventory value calculated based upon the physical inventory count and the Valuation Factors for the following categories defined in

the exhibits; Turns, Current Excess, Excess Promo, ExcessExcess and to the extent Purchaser purchases any other inventory however classified for 100% of the full, undiscounted carry value of such inventory. Discounted Inventory will not be subject to the net landed cost adjustment of EITF 02-16.

#### **Total Inventory Valuation**

The total inventory valuation, for each inventoried PSC, will be calculated as follows:

- 1. Final Physical Value for each PSC will be segregated between discounted and non-discounted inventory.
- 2. The EITF Percent will be applied only to the non-discounted inventory.
- 3. The total inventory valuation will be the sum of each inventoried PSC's total non-discounted inventory, less the EITF 02-16 adjustment, plus the discounted inventory.
