Dear Honorable Judge Walbrath:

I am a widow of Henry C. Reid, whom was an executive on Fleming's "Serp" retirement plan which I inherited upon my husband's death in 1985.

I have a small pension of \$700 gross - \$599 net with Fleming and \$1,127 from Social Security, which equals \$1,726 per month on which I can not survive.

My Executive "Serp" pension, which has been discontinued, paid me \$1,364 Gross and \$1,161 net every two weeks. This is a great deal of money to lose.

I have lived in my home for 24 years. Because of Fleming filing Chapter 11, I put my home up for sale last week.

The money I receive upon the sale of my home will be used up by expenses in two years. Then I don't know what will happen to me. I am 70 years old.

Please allow Fleming to pay their "Serp" benefits to their retirees.
