**OBJECTION OF WELLS FARGO FINANCIAL LEASING, INC. TO NOTICE OF
POTENTIAL ASSUMPTION AND ASSIGNMENT OF CERTAIN EXECUTORY
CONTRACTS AND UNEXPIRED LEASES IN CONNECTION WITH SALE MOTION**

Wells Fargo Financial Leasing, Inc. ("Wells Fargo") hereby files this objection to the Cure Notice, as states as follows:

1. The Cure Notice lists several contracts with Honeywell, Inc. (pages 51 and 52 of Cure Notice). Wells Fargo is the assignee of several contracts between the Debtors and Honeywell, Inc. A list of those contracts (with account numbers and copies of the contracts) are included in the Motion of Wells Fargo Financial Leasing, Inc. for Order (A) to Compel Debtor to Assume or Reject Lease Agreements, (B) to Compel Debtor to Timely Perform Its Obligations Under Lease Agreements, and (C) Allowance of Administrative Claim (the "Motion"), filed on July 15, 2003 (docket no. 1957). Wells Fargo can not determine from the information provided in the Cure Notice whether any of the contract included in that Cure Notice are contract to which it is the assignee. To the extent that any of the Honeywell, Inc. contracts listed in the Cure Notice have been assigned to Wells Fargo, it objects to the amount of the cure in the Cure Notice consistent with the amounts show as outstanding in the Motion, which is incorporated herein by reference.
