
**JOINDER OF OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED
CREDITORS OF FLEMING COMPANIES, INC., ET AL., IN DEBTORS'
OPPOSITION TO MOTION OF RELIANT ENERGY SOLUTIONS, LLC FOR
AN ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 503 AND 556 OF BANKRUPTCY
CODE (I) DETERMINING THAT FORWARD ELECTRIC ENERGY SALES
AGREEMENT HAS AUTOMATICALLY TERMINATED, (II) REQUIRING PAYMENT
OF ADMINISTRATIVE PRIORITY CLAIM FOR DELIVERY OF POST-PETITION
ELECTRICITY, AND (III) AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF ELECTRIC SERVICE
AT DEBTOR'S FACILITIES FROM RELIANT TO DEFAULT SERVICE PROVIDER
(Re Docket No. 2598)**

The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of Fleming Companies, Inc. and its affiliated debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned cases (the "Creditors' Committee"), hereby joins in the Debtors' Opposition To Motion Of Reliant Energy Solutions, LLC For An Order Pursuant To Sections 503 And 556 Of Bankruptcy Code (I) Determining That Forward Electric Energy Sales Agreement Has Automatically Terminated, (II) Requiring Payment Of Administrative Priority Claim For Delivery Of Post-Petition Electricity, And (III) Authorizing Transfer Of Electric Service At Debtor's Facilities From Reliant To Default Service Provider, filed July 31, 2003 (the "Opposition") to Motion Of Reliant Energy Solutions, LLC For An Order Pursuant To Sections 503 And 556 Of Bankruptcy Code (I) Determining That Forward Electric Energy Sales Agreement Has Automatically Terminated, (II) Requiring Payment Of Administrative Priority Claim For Delivery Of Post-Petition Electricity, And (III) Authorizing Transfer Of Electric Service At Debtor's Facilities From Reliant To Default Service Provider, filed July 16, 2003 (the "Motion"). The Creditors' Committee agrees with the legal position set forth in the Opposition. The Creditors' Committee hereby joins in the Opposition and reserves

all rights to (a) be heard before this Court with respect to the Motion and the Opposition, and (b) amend or supplement this Joinder.

WHEREFORE, the Creditors' Committee respectfully requests that the Court enter an order sustaining the Opposition; denying the Motion; and granting such other and further relief to the Debtors as it deems just and proper.
