

Upon the motion (the “**Motion**”)¹ of Medline Industries, Inc. (“**Medline**”) for an Order (i) allowing Medline’s claim of \$10,042.34 as an administrative claim under section 503(b)(1) (the “**503(b) Claim**”) of Title 11 of the United States Code (the “**Bankruptcy Code**”) and (ii) directing the Debtors to immediately pay the 503(b) Claim; and the Court having jurisdiction over the Motion under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and due and proper notice of the Motion having been provided and it appearing that no other or further notice is necessary; and upon consideration of the Motion and the relief requested and a hearing having been held before this Court; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion is granted; and it is further

ORDERED that the 503(b) Claim is allowed as an administrative expense claim under section 503(b)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code in the amount of \$10,042.34; and it is further

~~**ORDERED** that Debtors shall pay \$10,042.34 to Medline within five (5) days of entry of this Order, and it is further~~

ORDERED that any payment of the 503(b) Claim granted to Medline herein will be subject to a pro rata distribution with other allowed administrative claims; and it is further

ORDERED that to the extent the Debtors continue to purchase and receive additional goods from Medline that constitute actual, necessary costs and expenses of preserving the

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bankruptcy estates after April 18, 2017, Medline is allowed an administrative expense claim under section 503(b)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code for such amounts which come due after that time; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order is without prejudice to Medline's right to amend the amount of the 503(b) Claim, subject to the approval of this Court, and to request additional amounts owing; and it is further

ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or related to this Order.
