Indiana Department of Environmental Management Basis for Claim

Gas-Mart USA, Inc. is liable to the state of Indiana for underground storage tank fees and for the costs of corrective action for a release of petroleum at 323 Ridge Rd., Munster, Indiana, Lake County, Indiana (the "Site") under Indiana Code § 13-23-13-8 because it owned and operated underground storage tanks ("USTs") at the Site from October 2003 through the present.

The Site is identified in IDEM's files as Facility ID No. ("FID") 3559. UST fees are due for 4 years for 3 tanks at the Site. Per Indiana Code § 13-23-12-1 (b), UST fees are \$90 per tank. The total due is \$1080.

Release No. 200311508 occurred at the Site and corrective action is currently being performed at the direction of the former owner, ConocoPhillips. Should ConocoPhillips cease performing corrective action, Gas-Mart USA, Inc., will be responsible to perform corrective action.

The costs for corrective action at the Site, to bring the Site to a "No Further Action" status, are estimated at \$100,000.
